Seminar equips you to start a VORP

The Restorative Justice Project in cooperation with the Victim Offender Reconciliation Program (VORP) of the Central Valley, Inc. in Fresno, has designed a unique seminar for individuals and communities interested in starting a VORP in their area. Ron Claassen, founder of the Fresno VORP and Noelle Daoudian, VORP director, along with VORP staff will lead seminar participants through the challenging steps of launching a successful victim offender reconciliation program from concept to first case.

Design and materials

This annual seminar is designed for a 3-member team. Each team will receive a complete package of materials needed to initiate and operate a VORP, which includes:

- *VORP Organizing/Program Manual*
(with CD of program components)
- *Volunteer Training Manual*
- *Restorative Justice: Making Things Right* (video)

Location and facilities

This three day seminar is held adjacent to the campus of Fresno Pacific University, where the Fresno VORP is housed. Nearby hotels provide a discount for university guests and campus facilities include a dining hall and coffee shop.

VORP's Mission of Reconciliation

Fresno VORP works primarily with churches and the criminal justice system to offer reconciliation for people-both victims and offenders- whose lives have been turned upside-down by crime. VORP is founded on the principle of "restorative justice."

Justice is incomplete until:

- Injustices are recognized
- Equity is restored (may include restitution to victims)
- Future intentions are clarified

Since 1982, Fresno VORP has been utilizing a pioneering method of a Community Justice Process which brings together the offender, victim and extended families and communities to work out a restorative justice sentence.

Fresno VORP, supported by local churches and community organizations, works closely with probation and courts. Fresno VORP has become a national and international model for victim offender programs.
